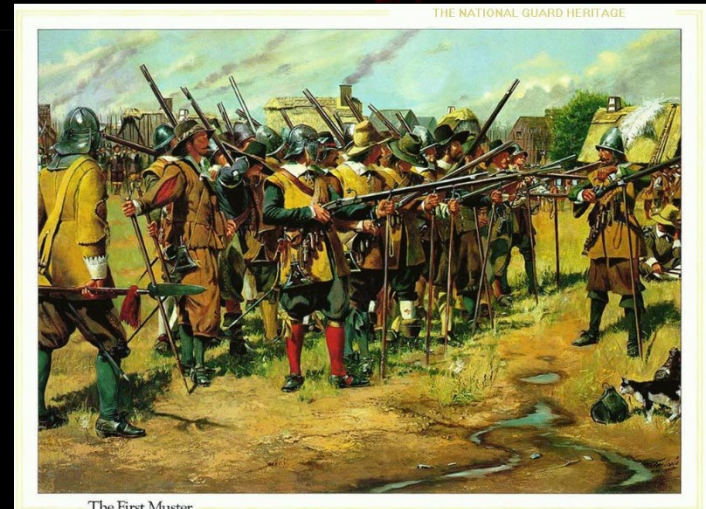

Our History



- **1636** Founding of the National Guard, when the Massachusetts Bay Colony organized its first three militia regiments
- **1865** Arizona stands up the First Arizona Volunteer Infantry Regiment
- **1912** Codification of the militia and designation as National Guard in Arizona Constitution, Article 16
- **1942** Creation of the Arizona Civilian Defense Board and Council, forerunner to AZ Division of Emergency Management (1971)
- **1972** Arizona Department of Emergency and Military Affairs (DEMA) established through integration of Department of Military Affairs (Arizona National Guard) and Division of Emergency Management

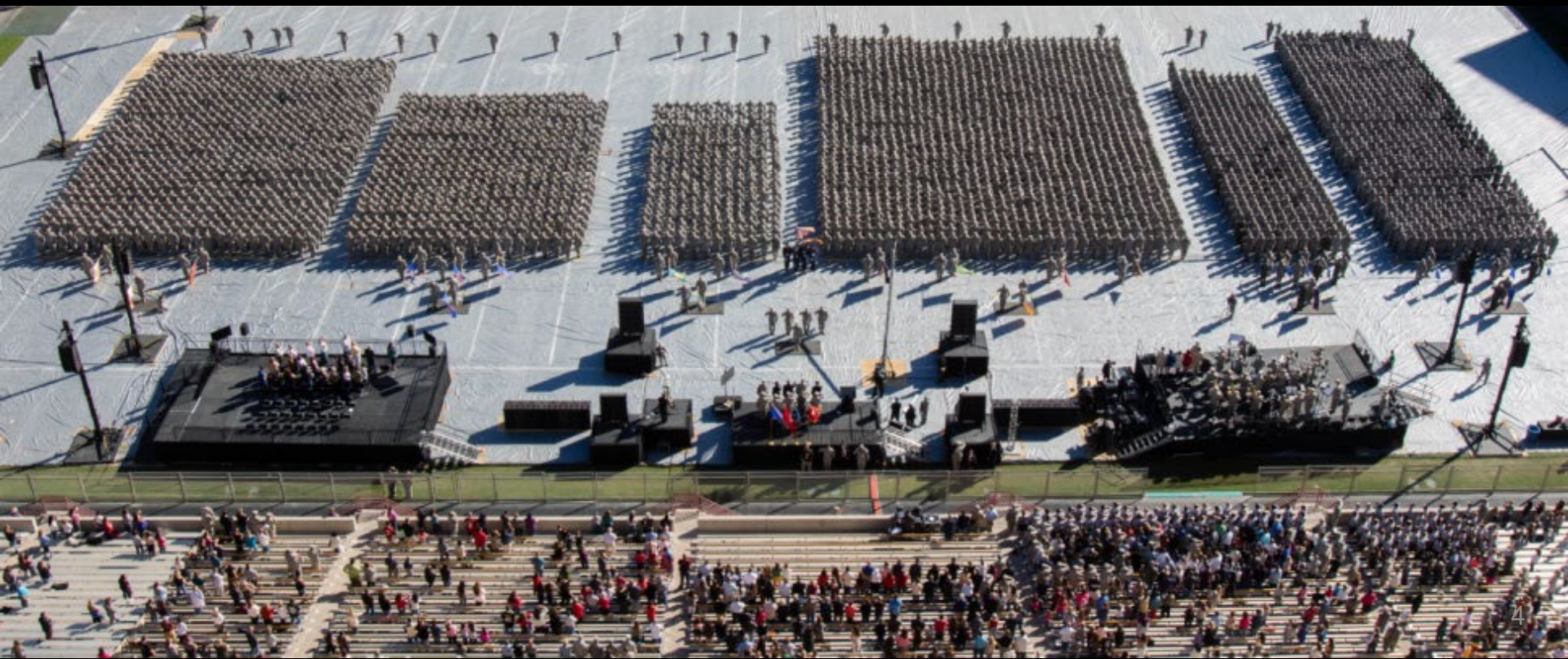

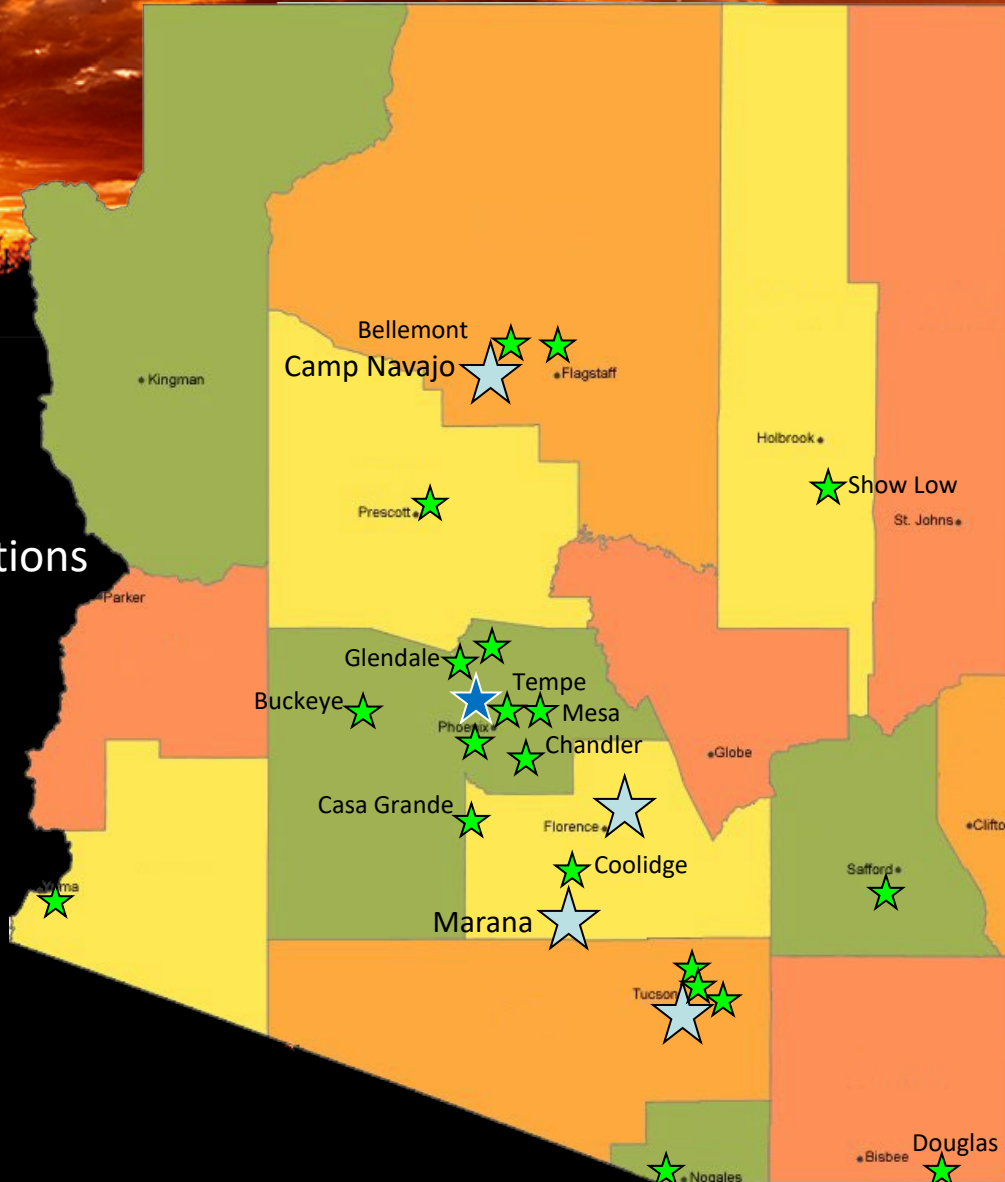

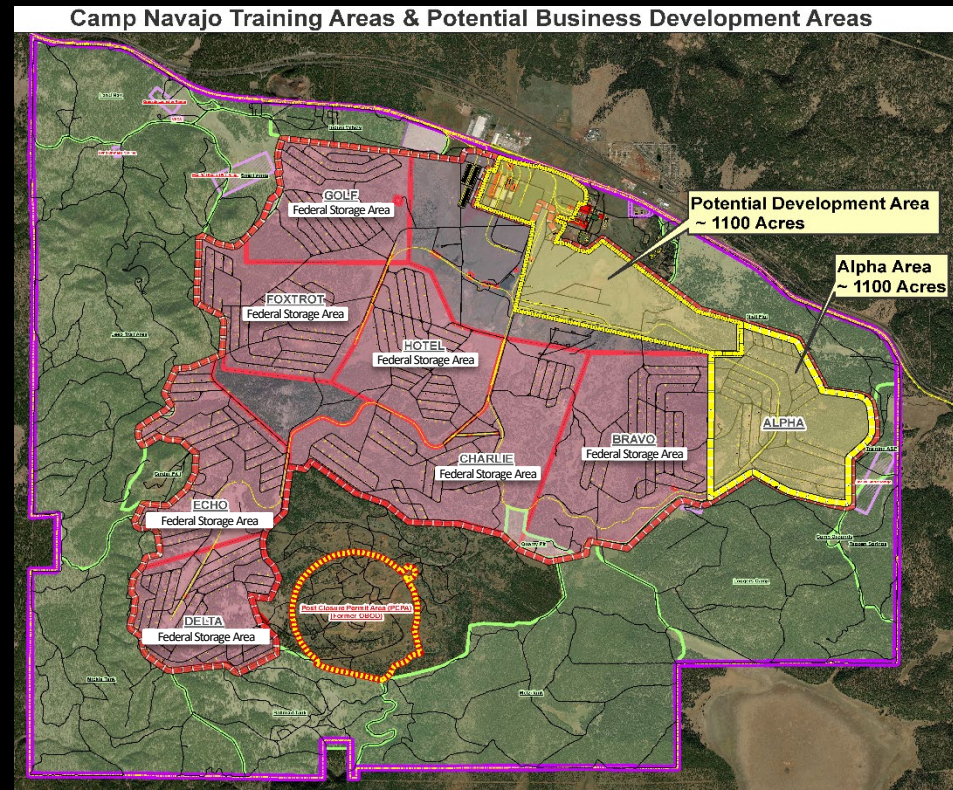
